It is the intention of this review to point out some problems facing regulatory officials involved in assessing the safety to man of drug residues in edible animal products which arise from procedures and techniques used in animal production.

Also discussed are some general principles, drawn from both animal and human medicine, that should be taken into account in any assessment of drug residue safety. The authors note that the use of drugs has become an accepted and necessary part of animal production in North America; however, the public health implications of drug residues in edible animal products are not clearly understood. From a public health point of view each drug must be considered individually, taking into account pharmacological, physicochemical, and toxicological principles.

It was concluded that there remains a pressing need for studies on the amounts, nature, biological availability, and toxicity to man of drug residues in edible animal products. (70 references)

### CANADIAN PHARMACISTS REALIZE A BETTER RETURN ON INVESTMENT

An economic comparison between community pharmacies in Canada and the United States was made.

The Annual Survey of Retail Pharmacy published by the Canadian Pharmaceutical Association and the Lilly Digest were used as source documents.

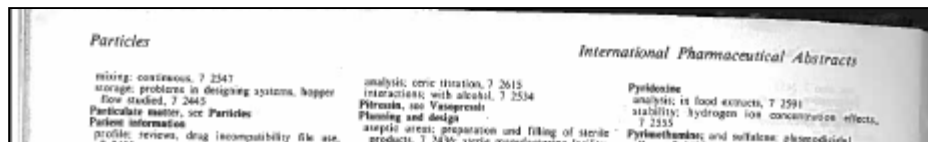
The average Canadian pharmacy realized a larger return on investment (22% vs. 19%). In both Canada and the U.S., the cost of goods sold, proprietor's salary, employees' wages, and rent were comparable. American pharmacies paid higher taxes and insurance. Proprietors in both countries earned comparable incomes. But, the American owner worked more hours per week (55 vs. 50). The break-even point for the average American pharmacy was 9.4 months or 78.9% of sales; for the average Canadian pharmacy it was 8.7 months and 74.9% of sales.

Quantitative economic data places the average Canadian community pharmacy slightly ahead of its American counterpart.

## Use of Medical Subject Headings For Cataloging - 2014

With few exceptions, catalogers apply the same basic principles as those used by indexers in assigning MeSH terms for the subject analysis of bibliographic materials. - Se não colocaram um MeSH: Não se localiza um artigo:
  - Não faz parte da evidencia (revisões sistemáticas).
  - Não é citado.
