Overall, the article is well written and the main message is clear. However I feel that the rather assertive tone used throughout this manuscript, particularly in the first paragraphs, is too strong to be used without substancial citation of literature.

I would recommend either softening the tone to better convey the degree of uncertainty that most likely applies to most assertions, or alternatively cite work that gives solid ground to the assertions. I would recommend work by Kerfoot, and Cook. There are also minor typos and grammatical structures that need correction or rewording.
